## MORNING TEA TO MARK THE 60<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE LIONS CLUB OF CLARENCE REMARKS BY

Good morning, everyone, and a very warm welcome to Government House to mark a significant milestone of 60 years of the Lions Club of Clarence.

I begin by acknowledging the Muwinina people upon whose Country we gather. I acknowledge today's Tasmanian Aboriginal Community as ongoing custodians of Country. I recognise their enduring culture and continued connection to land, sea, and waters.

This Lions Club has been at the heart of the Clarence community for six decades. Established in 1964, your Club has continued to demonstrate dedicated community spirit.

Over the decades, you have raised an impressive 3 million dollars to support a broad range of causes. Last year, your club raised \$92,000 through the hard work and generosity of your 24 members. With an average age of 75 years and more than half of your members having served for over 25 years, you prove that age is no barrier to making a difference.<sup>1</sup>

You support local education through student scholarships for grade 10 students. Your breakfast club program for local high schools ensures that no child starts their day hungry.<sup>2</sup>

In times of crisis, your Lions Club of Clarence has consistently stepped forward, responding to bushfires in Tasmania, Victoria, and South Australia and providing relief during floods in Queensland and New South Wales. You have supported international disaster appeals, from the Asian tsunami to the Vanuatu cyclone and Nepalese earthquake.
